Beverage Guidelines for Hillcrest Party

80 Guests for a 2 hour event

Typical quantities for alcohol consumption for an event with 80 guests for two hours. Buyers should know their guests best and be able to identify their beverage preferences.

Wine Only Event

- Average person has 3 glasses (240 glasses)
- A bottle of wine will pour 5 glasses
- Need 4 cases minimum
- Event percentage of white verses red is 50/50
- The percentage varies depending on crowd.

Mixed Drinks Event

- Average person has 3 glasses
- Average amount of alcohol in each drink is 2 oz. (This is more than standard because the drinks are poured without measuring)
- Total amount of alcohol would be 7.5 half gallons.
- In winter months there may be more Scotch & Bourbon consumed, so adjust the amount.
- Alcohol:
 - Vodka 3 Half Gallons
 - Gin 2 Half Gallons
 - Scotch 1 Half Gallon
 - Bourbon 1 Half Gallon
 - Rum 1 Fifth

Event where the beverage is mixed between wine & mixed drinks

- Expect guests to be split almost 50/50 between wine & mixed drinks.
- 2 cases of wine minimum.
- Alcohol:
 - Vodka 2 Half Gallons
 - Gin 1 Half Gallon
 - Scotch 1 Half Gallon
 - Bourbon 1 Half Gallon
 - Rum 1 Fifth

Event is a Martini Party

- Average person has 2 drinks.
- There are 3 oz per glass. Measure the martini glass to be sure since sizes can vary.
- Recommend 70% Vodka and 30% Gin.
- Total number -7 Half Gallons
 - Vodka 5 Half Gallons
 - Gin 2 Half Gallons
 - Vermouth 1 Fifth
