

**Bylaws Hillcrest Committee for the benefit of the American Cancer Society,
Founded 1946**

The President Elect heads the Hospitality Committee.

The Hospitality Committee sends a single yellow rose or card to members when appropriate.

You are the Yellow Rose committee of one. Basically you send or take a Yellow Rose to the members who have had an illness or surgery or death in the family. Also condolence cards.

It's always the incoming President that does it and Julie McLaughlin has been doing it this year.

There are a few unwritten rules;

- Only the member (current or Excalibur) gets a yellow rose.
- A card is sent for the immediate family member.

The Hillcrest Committee has an account at "Susie's" on Crater Lake Ave., and they do deliver, but it is expensive. If I had the time, I would deliver myself. Difficult when a member has lost her husband, but worth the extra effort and very appreciated by the member.

Sometimes, we don't find out until after the fact that a member, whether active or Excalibur, should receive a yellow rose.....but late or not, we generally always make sure a rose is provided!
